

# Lord's Prayer

At St Mary's this week we have been looking at the Lord's prayer.

The church has been set up to look at one line at a time. The children and adults have had an opportunity to sit at 7 prayer stations. The last station allowed the children to think about how God has made them unique.

If they could ask God one thing what would it be?

#### Reflecting on the Lord's Prayer

The Lord's Prayer has shaped the lives of Jesus' followers ever since he first taught it to his disciples. Rooted in Jesus' relationship to the Father, the prayer encompasses the whole of life, inviting us to pray for God's presence and power to change the world and to change us.

The Lord's Prayer is found in two versions in the New Testament (Matthew 6:9-13; Luke 11:2-4). In Matthew's Gospel, it sits alongside Jesus' teaching on giving and fasting, while in Luke's Gospel, it is followed by Jesus' teaching on the importance of persistence and faith in prayer. Although Luke's shorter version may be closer to Jesus' original prayer, Matthew's longer version fills out the details and is closest to that used in churches today. For those familiar with the Lord's Prayer, it is easy to rush through the words without always grasping what they mean.
