Isaiah 43:19

See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.

Our screens have been too full of 'wastelands' in recent weeks – whether they be the multi-million dollar homes of the Palisades razed to the ground by fire, the once leafy suburbs of northern Gaza flattened by bombs, or, more chillingly, the horror that met the liberating forces as they discovered Auschwitz-Birkenau hidden in the forest.

Apologies if that is a gloomy way to start a cheery newsletter, but it is only perhaps when we understand how 'wilderness and wasteland', and 'darkness and despair' are all products of a fallen and fractured humanity and world, that we grasp just how powerful and transformative is 'the Living Water' and 'Light of the World' that is the Christ, our Lord Jesus.

Wherever Jesus went, he 'did a new thing', for wherever he went, he himself was the answer to the prayer that he taught us to pray – 'your Kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven'. He brought in the Kingdom – the blind saw, the lame walked, the demons were cast out, the dead rose. He taught his disciples to do the work of the Kingdom too, and when he left them he told them to make more disciples, and he empowered them with the Holy Spirit.

That is our heritage, and that is our mission as Christ's body, the church, in Hartfield, Coleman's Hatch and Cowden – to bring the living water and the light of Christ to our communities, today. That mission and the ministry that goes with it will look a little different in every 'season', as context, communities and churches change over time.

For us, right now, that means our three churches working in prayerful partnership to support and encourage one another. I hope that you will find that this monthly newsletter 'inSPIRES' you to want to get involved in the life of our three churches - each building standing with its tall spire centrally in our villages, and each church family bringing light and hope to those who live there, in the name of Christ.


Everyone's welcome. You're invited, no matter your viewpoint. It's free and there's no pressure to come back.
